Story Behind the Wine

Buffalo Roam is one of our fan favorite wines, our customers even competed in a challenge to name the delicious red blend wine. The only information about the wine that was given in the naming competition was that it was a Rhone style blend of Syrah and Mourvèdre. The winning name was Buffalo Rhome, which later has morphed into 'Buffalo Roam'.

Wine Composition & Vinification

68% 2014 Petite Sirah (Sourced from California)
22% 2014 Tempranillo (Nubbin Ridge Vineyards, Cross Plains TX)
10% 2013 Cinsault (Reddy Vineyards, TX High Plains)

Production: 685 cases

Finished Wine: 13.1 % alcohol, pH 3.70, 0.1% Residual Sugar

Tasting Notes

Appearance: Ruby Red in color with a light brick rim; and medium plus intensity.

Nose: Youthful, fruit forward wine with aromas of sour cherries and cranberry.

Palate: Dry, medium-full bodied red wine with fruit flavors of black plums, currants, and blue berries. Non-fruit flavors present are smoke driven with notes of pipe tobacco, and wet leather. Wine shows well-balanced structure that provides a round and robust mouth feel. Medium tannin structure allows this sturdy wine to be paired with an array of food dishes ranging from BBQ, grilled game bird, and beef tenderloin. Well-rounded and silken mouth feel also embrace this as a wonderful patio sipping wine.
