Vintage Notes

The 2019 harvest turned out to be a beautiful one producing an abundance of fruit. Due to enough rain throughout the season and no freeze threat, the vines stayed well hydrated and plenty nourished which kick started an early harvest. Thankfully, the bountiful harvest will provide us extra fruit for the future.

Harvest and Vinification Notes

100% Semillon - Newburg Vineyard, Comanche County TX Yeast: ES 181. Mechanically harvested and pressed. Skin contact in press only, fermented at 52 degrees. Finished Wine: 13.8 % Alcohol, 3.26 pH, 0.0% Residual Sugar, 221 Cases

Sasting Notes

Appearance: Pale straw in color with a green watery rim Nose: White peach, white florals of gardenia and magnolia, fresh cut grass, key lime zest and white tea

Palate: Medium minus structure, bright crisp acids which are rounded out by citrus candied lemon and chamomile tea.

Pair with pork tenderloin, shrimp scampi, and a caprese flatbread with balsamic glaze.
